



## FAQ

### **What is a gap year or summer experience program?**

It's important to bring God to the center of your life while making big decisions. Taking an intentional year off from school or spending a summer abroad can actually propel you into making the most of your college experience, or whatever you may decide to do.

### **Where do you live?**

Each student will share accommodations with other students in the home of their host family. In the home there will be 2-3 family style meals per day. Students will also share in the household responsibilities.

### **Where will I be serving?**

Sparrow Missions has many different ministries in San Pedro Sula. Students will have the opportunity to be a part of each of these ministries and more during your time with us. Sparrow also has a Children's home about an hour away.

### **Do I have to know Spanish?**

No, but it would help. Once accepted, we will give you Spanish phrases to learn before you arrive. Also as part of both programs, you will learn Spanish during the week in a classroom setting.

### **What is included in the program costs?**

Included in the program costs are room, food, in-country transportation, internet, Spanish language learning, Teaching English as a Second Language training and field trips.

### **What is not included?**

Not included in the program costs are passports/fees, airline travel, cell phone, immunizations or any other personal spending. You will be given a list of items you will need to bring with you.

### **Will I have any personal time?**

Yes, you will have personal time every day. During this time, we encourage prayer and bible study. Some weekends there will be opportunities to take trips to other parts of Honduras.
